**AZZAWIYA REFINERY LIBYA REFURBISHMENT**

The Libyan Authority has withdrawn its tender for the refurbishment of the Azzawiya Refinery. The National Oil Company is now seeking expressions of interest from industry to purchase an ownership position in the Azzawiya Refinery, as well as a commitment to finance its refurbishment. WINFIELD will review this new opportunity with CKG Libya Branch; our refurbishment joint venture partner.

**TOBRUK, LIBYA**

WINFIELD has been awarded a US\$250,000 contract to service the NOC oil refinery located in Tobruk Libya. Dr. Danilo Mancin, President of WINFIELD LIBYA BRANCH, is managing the project and has engaged technical support from Tunisia. This contract fulfills WINFIELD LIBYA BRANCH's Registration requirement to complete a contract in Libya within the first year of Registration. As well, WINFIELD is now on the NOC's list of approved service providers.

**ZARZIS, TUNISIA**

WINFIELD has applied to the Tunisian Authority to Build, Own and Operate a 300,000 barrel per day oil refinery in the ZARZIS Tax Free Zone. Contingent to regulatory acceptance WINFIELD must negotiate crude oil feedstock contracts with either SONATRACH of Algeria or NOC of Libya. WINFIELD has arranged 100% debt financing subject to certain performance covenants. This initiative comes with the encouragement of the local Authorities

**HIGH LEVEL ALBERTA ETHANOL – FEEDLOT FACILITY**

WINFIELD awaits a February 2007 feasibility report from TDI TECHNOLOGY on a proposed new 20 million litre per year integrated ETHANOL – FEEDLOT Facility

**NORTHERN BRITISH COLUMBIA ETHANOL FACILITY**

WINFIELD is conducting due diligence on a particular technology license that uses wood waste as its feed stock to create fuel ETHANOL. Upon confirmation of its utility, WINFIELD will engage TDI TECHNOLOGY INC. to prepare a full Feasibility Report on a wood waste to ETHANOL Facility for a Northern BC location.

**EAST AFRICA**

At the request of the Rwandan Government WINFIELD engaged TDI TECHNOLOGY INC. to investigate the potential of WINFIELD engineering, procuring, constructing and managing a new fuel ETHANOL Facility using indigenous feed stocks. Mr. Sid Jaycock, P.Eng., [ President of TDI TECHNOLOGY INC. ] has recently returned from a preliminary scoping study in Rwanda. It is now our purpose to identify the most appropriate feedstock and the optimal technology necessary to transforming the biomass into fuel ethanol. WINFIELD is seeking 100% debt finance to build a 45 million litre per year facility.
